comments and advises on them.

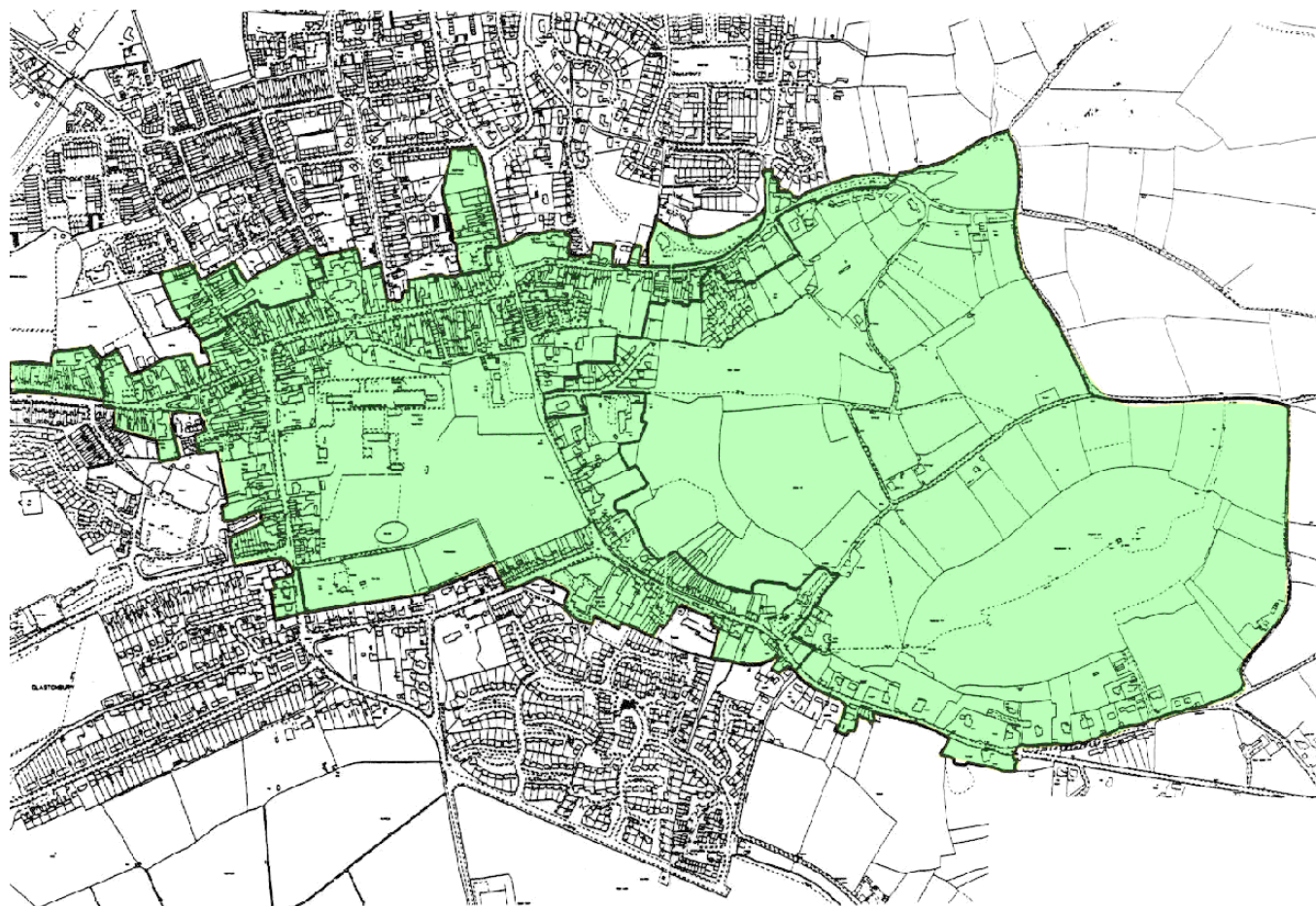
It publishes regular newsletters,
